You must file the completed form between January 1 and April 30 of this year. Be sure to attach any additional documents requested. You only need to apply once for this exemption unless the warehouse changes ownership or the cotton's current qualification for the exemption changes. However, the chief appraiser must deliver you a written notice that a new application is required, accompanied by an application form. If you have filled out this form online, you must print it, sign it, and mail the form to the address above.
