PROHIBITION ON CONTRACTS WITH COMPANIES BOYCOTTING ISRAEL

	Sec. 2271.002. PROVISION REQUIRED IN CONTRACT. (a) This section applies only to a contract
that:	(1) is between a governmental entity and a company with 10 or more full-time employees;
and	
	(2) has a value of \$100,000 or more that is to be paid wholly or partly from public funds of
the gov	vernmental entity.
	(b) A governmental entity may not enter into a contract with a company for goods or services

- (1) does not boycott Israel; and
- (2) will not boycott Israel during the term of the contract.

unless the contract contains a written verification from the company that it:
